VOLUNTEERS: Jess Morret

- 153 unique families in 2025 (No Midget)
- Need 97 volunteers per day (105 if we need to staff announcer and scoreboard)
 - 485 Volunteer slots over the whole season
 - Slots:
 - Cleanup 4
 - Smurf Ref
 - Chain Gang 12
 - Spotter 4
 - Main Gate 10
 - Back Gate 5
 - Parking 9
 - 50/50 8
 - Spirit wear 5
 - Program Sales 10
 - Concessions 29 *can be shaved down*
- Recommendations:
 - 1) 4 volunteer slots, no food donations
 - Unanimous vote from members present tonight was this option
 - 2) 3 volunteer slots, 1 food donations
 - Increase buy out option to \$200 check
- Extra credit slots will still offer discount for next season
 - This does not apply to board members or their immediate families

- Need to cap the age for volunteers
- What are we doing if someone does not show up for their signed up event?
 - If you miss your shift, you either find a filler or you loose your \$200 if you do not have board member approval

OTHER POINTS OF INTEREST:

- CFA submitted bylaw changes - only big one is doing away with uniform gate fees for games and allow each organization to set their own fees
- Picture Night - July 30th
 - Brittany will submit the facility request (see last month notes)
- Brittany reviewed the registration questions and settings for go live this Friday
- Brittany reviewed the Equipment Handout Packet information
 - Need to look into folders or bags to lump everything together and handout
