 - Other organizations have started to inquire
- Meeting was held with Chuck Thomas (Jr High Coach), Angie Gaido (AD), Coach Miller (Varsity Coach) and Assistant Athletic Director
 - We are looking to create a longitudinal relationship and support each other
- Chuck Thomas and Ross Fronk have a plan in place to help coordinate between the JR high team and the midgets
- Pig Skin Prep Camp June 10-14
 - It has been requested by Coach Miller that NYFC not hold their own camp during the proposed dates as Northern Football is holding their Pig skin prep camp the following week
 - Ross has made the suggestion that we cancel the NYFC camp completely and help with the Pig Skin Prep Camp
 - Put our own program together for the youth level for the split sessions
 - Bring our own Coaches
 - Split profits or donation to NYFC
 - Current NYFC standing: We are willing to participate in Pig skin prep and not hold our camp. This is dependent on the amount of profit that is shared with the NYFC.

- Registration is almost ready to go Brittany and Danielle met to go over website and are up to speed and will be ready for March 1st
 - Competition cheer will have more details on requirements of girls
 - Anti-bullying policy will be included in required forms for Football this year
 - 101 cheerleaders signed up for 2023 season
- Cheer and tumble clinic are going on right now with 37 girls currently in attendance
 - A few of the girls have financial struggles
 - Ed brought up the Rider Williams foundation for financial assistance; is this still something that is available to us? Amanda and Danielle said it was still available Amanda will be reaching out to the foundation to ensure relationship
- Several Varsity cheerleaders are coming down to assist with coaching Remaining coaches are established for this year
- Smurf competition this year is cut back -will only compete in 3
- Uniforms will have a fitting date as well as a hand out date
- Suggested purchases:
 - Provide garment bags to each girl to ensure uniforms are taken care of better
 - \$200 approx cost Voted on during meeting: APPROVED
 - Purchase new plastic boards for cheer signs
 - \$80 approx cost Voted on during meeting: APPROVED
 - Purchase cheer flags for competitions
 - \$750 approx cost Voted on during meeting: APPROVED
 - Competition bow material
 - \$100 approx cost Voted on during meeting: APPROVED
- All cheer facility requests have been submitted for the rest of the year
 - July 29 Parent meeting in Cafeteria
- Purse BINGO was moved from March to April 14, 2024
 - Volunteer signup will be sent out in the beginning of March
 - Tickets are in the works waiting for finalization of those
 - \circ \$25 a ticket for pre-purchase or \$30 at the door
 - Raffle baskets have been reached out and great response is coming back
 - Cody will still be in charge of concessions
 - Looking for donations
 - BYOB but not your own food

TREASURER REPORT: Amanda Divitorre

- Timberview Vet requested sponsorship letter be sent out
- Feedback is that sponsorship letters were sent out too soon
 - \circ Next year we should send out in February 2025
- Add Swopes Salvage East Berlin to sponsorship list
- \$1,550 in sponsorships so far
- \$4,125 in volunteer checks from 2023 season
- Next year we are increasing the volunteer fee to \$150 VOTED AND APPROVED
- Next year we will be increasing the cost of registration to \$150 VOTED AND APPROVED
 - Just sideline \$100
 - Sideline and competition \$150
 - Midget level FREE
- \$34,000 in bank as of today 1/30/2024
- Signing SEG Letter for Members 1st to help with community partnership
- Amanda has requested to reach out to the HS announcer and see if we can pay him to be the official announcer for NYFC
- Entry Fees will be raised to \$5 adult \$3 student No more family discount VOTED AND APPROVED
 - Punch cards are not Valid
 - Website needs to be updated with new charges
